

JUILUS CAESAR : ACT 1 YEAR 5 AND YEAR 6 GRAMMAR EXERCISE PASSIVE VERBS

You use passive verbs to affect the presentation of information in a sentence: when the subject of a sentence isn't doing something, the verb is passive.

Subject → Person or thing that does the action

Object → Person or things that the action is done to

Verb → An action, or state of being

When the <u>subject</u> of the sentence is performing the action a sentence is written in **active** voice.

When the subject of a sentence has something done to it by someone or something the sentence is written in the **passive** voice.

For example;

<u>Caesar asked</u> Brutus who the strange man was. → **ACTIVE** (subject) (verb) (object)

Brutus was asked by Caesar who the strange man was. PASSIVE (object) (verb). (subject)
