## **CONTEXT**



Meanwhile the English Army led by Malcolm, joins forces with the Scottish Army to seek revenge and topple Macbeth from the throne. The two armies decide that each soldier should carry a branch of forest to disguise themselves as they march to Dunsinane Castle. The final scene of the play sees Lady Macbeth die and Macduff kill Macbeth. Malcolm, the rightful heir to the throne, is finally due to be crowned King.

# MAP THE FOLLOWING COORDINATES



1. Write 'C' in (1,1) to show the location of Cawdor castle. Duncan makes Macbeth Thane of Cawdor.
2. Write 'S' in (-5,2) to show the Isle of Skye where part of the 2015 adaptation of Macbeth was filmed.
3. Write 'O' in (2,-2) to show Dunsinane Hill where Macbeth was eventually slain.
4. Write 'T' in (3,2) to show Elgin, the place where King Duncan was murdered in the recent film.
5. Write 'N' in (-4,-2) to show Isle of Mule, where Kings of Scotland were laid to rest.
6. Write 'L' in (5,1) to show Cairn O' Mounth where in 1054, Malcolm, son of Duncan, led an invasion of Alba.
7. Write 'D' in (1,-3) to show The Birnam Oak. It is said to be the last surviving tree of the wood from which Malcolm's soldiers cut branches to camouflage their attack on Macbeth at Dunsinane Hill.
8. Write 'A' (-1,1) to show Dingwall where the real King Macbeth was born in 1005.
