

JUILUS CAESAR ACT 4 YEAR 5 AND 6 GRAMMAR: MODAL VERBS

Modal verbs are verbs words that change the meaning of other verbs. They are used to show whether something is certain, likely, possible or impossible.

EXAMPLE:

"Octavius Caesar will win the battle"

'will' is the modal verb here as it indicates that Octavius Caesar will win the battle

Read the example sentences in the table below. Look at how the meaning of the sentence changes depending on which modal verb is changed.

PURPOSE	EXAMPLE OF MODAL VERBS	EXAMPLE SENTENCE	
Likely/Permission	may, might	Octavius Caesar might win the battle	
Possibility/Impossibility	can, could, can't	Octavius Caesar could win the battle	
Certainty	will, would	Octavious Caesar will win the battle	
Obligation, advice	Shall, should, must	Octavius Caesar should win the battle
