PLANNING YOUR PLAY SCRIPT:

Before you start writing your dialogue, create a rough plan. You can use the boxes below to help you write down your notes/ideas. Later on in the week, if you make the puppets you could use them to act out your play or you could act out, casting other members of your family in the different roles. They'll have to learn their lines and any stage directions!

SETTING (Describe what the 'set' would look like, e.g. beach, palm trees, blue sky)

CHARACTERS (Note down the name of any of the characters who will be in your scene. It may be useful to describe what they are like, e.g. Antonio- not trustworthy/power hungry)

STAGE DIRECTIONS (It may be useful to think about things that you might want to happen, e.g. sound of waves crashing on the shore/ swords lifted up high)
