In Act IV, Macbeth revisits the witches to have his future told again, time is passing for Macbeth. This French lesson aims to revise numbers, days, months, seasons and time.

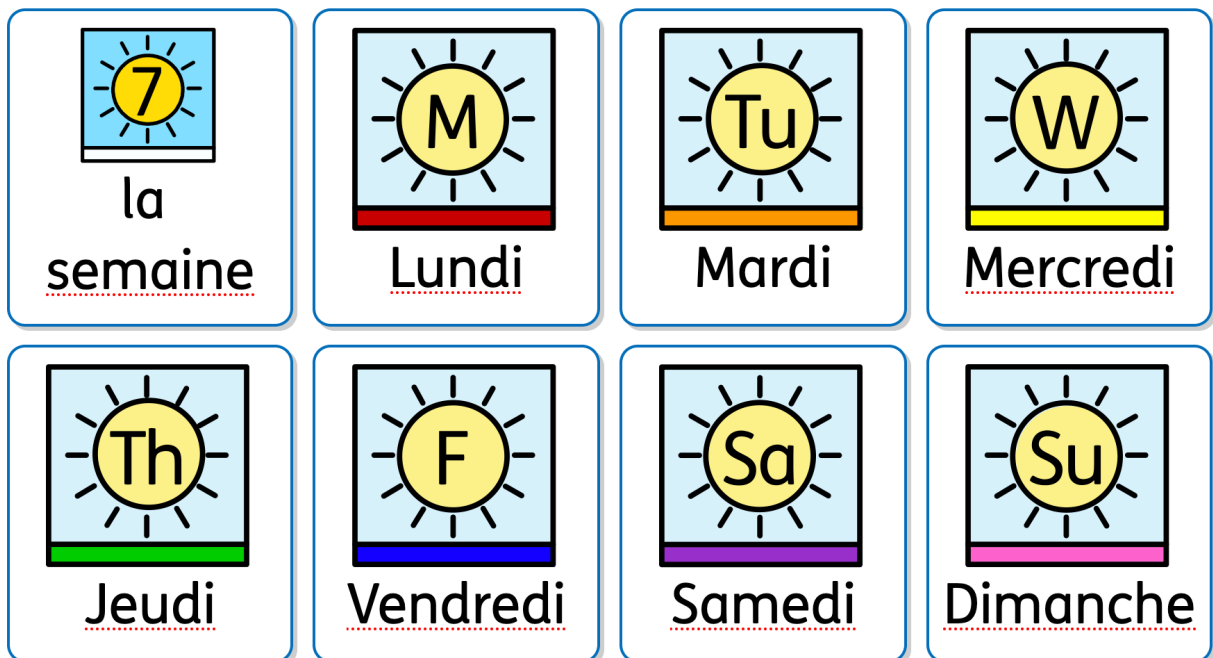
For this task you may need printouts of:
