

TWELFTH NIGHT: ACT 4 YEAR 3 AND YEAR 4 GRAMMAR EXERCISE: CAUSAL CONJUNCTIONS AND ADVERBIALS

Conjunctions → Words that show actions, motions, doing, or states of being. They can also demonstrate how someone feels.
A sentence cannot work without an action verb

Conjunctions extend sentences by joining clauses together.

Causal conjunctions explain how things work or why something has happened. They link cause and effect, e.g. **Sir Andrew wanted to leave because Olivia didn't love him.**

Causal Conjunctions- links causes and effects

As a result	Because	Consequently
Due to the fact	For this reason	Therefore
So that	Subsequently	In order to
In this way	In order that	Otherwise
