Calculate how many cakes were on each table.


3. Over 3 days, the shepherd stacked 3,764 logs onto 4 wagons.

How many logs were there on each wagon?




4. The shepherd organises his sheep in groups – called flocks.


Which of these numbers could be the size of a prime-numbered flock of sheep?
Explain why.




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
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5. Polixenes collected 3,960 coins and shared them equally between 9 guards.
